

# Team Detroit VBC and JCC COVID-19 Protocols for 2021

All athletes, coaches, referees, spectators, or any other individuals who would like to enter the Jewish Community Center (JCC) MUST adhere to all the Covid-19 protocols and policies stated below. No exceptions will be made. Anyone found in violation of these protocols will be escorted from the building and no refunds given.

1. Steps to complete prior to game day:
  - a. Health Screen. Click the link below within 24 hours of your tournament start time and answer all questions. Do NOT complete this screen in advance of the 24-hour period prior to your start time. Failure to submit the health screen in time will prevent entry into JCC on the day of your event.   - b. Team Roster. Ensure that each team has a printed AAU roster which lists all athletes and coaches. Athletes or coaches on that roster that do not complete the Health Screen above will not be allowed in the building.
  - c. Spectators. We will allow 1 spectator per rostered athlete.
2. Tournament Day Activities (Entrance protocols):
  - a. All personnel must wear a mask at all times while in JCC.
  - b. Anyone who answered “yes” to the screening questions, is feeling sick, or is showing any symptoms of Covid-19 should stay home and is prohibited from entry.
  - c. Coaches (or appointed team representative) will enter the JCC lobby in the IHC (west side of the building) at the designated time to check in their team.
  - d. If you are in the afternoon wave, you will not be allowed to enter until your designated time; we need time to sanitize all equipment and areas following the morning wave of play.
  - e. Due to limited space and the need to prevent massive amounts of people trying to enter at once, no athletes or spectators will be allowed in at this time.
  - f. Coach will submit the AAU roster and receive the required number of wrist bands for their team’s spectators. We will verify eligibility of all athletes and coaches at this time.
  - g. Coach will then proceed outside to gather their team and distribute wristbands.
  - h. Teams will be allowed to enter 1 at a time (to alleviate congestion) and proceed directly to their court.
  - i. Once all teams have entered, spectators will then be allowed to enter. To gain entry, all spectators must:
    - i. Show wristband
    - ii. Have a health screen on file, completed within 24 hours (max)
    - iii. Pay the admission fee
  - j. Spectators will then proceed to their courts.

### 3. Tournament Day Activities (During Play):

- a. To minimize personnel in the facility and minimize time spent not playing, the format for all events is a quad-style format. Our pools consist of 4 teams on 2 courts with plenty of space and distance between them. Teams will play each other in best 2 of 3 set format with a 1-hour time limit and then move on to play the next team. Team Detroit will supply the referee and teams will supply volunteers for other work duties. Thus, all teams will play, play, play and then leave.
- b. We will limit the number of people at the score table to 2; 1 will keep score and 1 will track substitutions.
- c. To reduce the risk of contact spread, we will supply all warm-up balls; teams must not bring in any balls.
- d. Teams and spectators that move to the adjacent court must pick up all trash before leaving their area and moving on to the next match.
- e. Spectators must maintain social distancing of 6' between each other if not in the same household.
- f. Use of the track in JCC is prohibited. All spectators must limit themselves to stay on their assigned court or use of the restrooms if needed.
- g. Spectators should not gather in any groups while in JCC; gatherings must be limited to outdoor areas.

### 4. Tournament Day Activities (After Play):

- a. After completing their 3<sup>rd</sup> match of the day, teams should clean up their area and exit the building.
- b. If you are in the morning wave of play, we have another group coming in behind you and need to sanitize all our equipment and space.

## Safety Control Measures

We will use the following control measures to ensure everyone who enters JCC is symptom-free, our facilities remain virus-free, and we minimize exposure to any potential hazards.

- We sanitize all equipment and areas after each use with CDC certified cleaning agents.
- Team Detroit has 2 staff members who are CDC certified contact tracers and graduates of the Johns Hopkins University training program. All protocols and control measures comply with all CDC recommendations.
- JCC is currently closed to all other activities at this time (i.e. only Team Detroit activities) which allows us to strictly control all Covid mitigation measures.
- Common areas such as restrooms and entrance area cleaned regularly throughout the day.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout JCC for frequent use by all participants.
- All personnel must come at their appointed time and leave immediately following the conclusion of activities (no early arrivals or late departures).
- Everyone must enter and leave wearing a mask; Masks are mandated while on your court. Team Detroit VBC masks are available for purchase if necessary.
- We encourage everyone to use the restroom at home before coming to JCC; if anyone needs to use the restroom, do not congregate in the restrooms – wait in the hallway if toilets are being used. Restrooms will be sanitized multiple times during the day.
- Each athlete should bring a full water bottle; the water fountain should be avoided and if necessary, used only to fill a water bottle.
